Purpose: A discussion about groundwater use in the Cuyama Valley, and a request for community input to update the Cuyama Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP) for 2025

Major Topics and Questions to be Discussed

- Status of groundwater use in the Cuyama Basin and what the CBGSA learned in the last few years.
- Groundwater monitoring networks and proposed improvements:
 - Information collection and forecasting groundwater use.
 - Groundwater monitoring networks – What they are, why are they important, what's new?
 - Request for public feedback on improvements to the monitoring networks.
- Criteria for evaluating groundwater sustainability:
 - How performance goals help achieve groundwater sustainability.
 - Discussion and community input on potential approaches to setting performance goals in the basin.
- Approach for groundwater pumping allocations:
 - Groundwater flow and overdraft in the Cuyama Basin.
 - Implementation of pumping reductions in the basin.
 - Possible pumping allocation approaches and tradeoffs. What areas of the Cuyama Basin should be subject to pumping allocations?
 - Request for public input to help determine future boundaries and pumping allocations.
